- 1. Applicant must be employed full time and attending an accredited institution of higher learning (college, university, etc.).
- 2. Applicant must be a minimum of 25 years of age
- 3. Applicant's major field of study must be one of the following:
 - Fine Arts (art, music, dance, theater, film, photography, et.)
 - Education
 - Health and/or Human Services (including but not limited to, social work, law, law enforcement, firefighting, transportation, environmental science, medicine, nursing, pharmacology)
 - Political Science
 - Broadcast Communications/Journalism
- 4. Applicant must be an active member of Park Windsor Baptist Church.
- 5. Applicant must submit a 500 word (minimum), typewritten essay detailing long-term goals upon completion of formal education and how the CLACS will assist in accomplishing these

goals.

- 6. Applicant must submit enrollment verification and current official transcript.
- 7. Applicant must be interviewed by CLACS Committee upon completion of the application process
- 8. CLACS recipient <u>must provide</u> one year of mentoring to a middle or high school student at Park Windsor Baptist Church

Applications are available each year the first week of July and all applications for consideration must be submitted no later than the first week of September. The scholarship(s) are normally awarded during PWBC's Homecoming celebration at the end of September.
